- 1. Everyone changed with a penal offence has the right to presumed innocent until proved guilty according to aw in public trial at which he has all the guarantees necessary for his defense.
- 2. No one shall be held guilty of any penal offence on account of any act or omission which did not constitute a penal offense, under national or international law, at the time when it was not committed nor shall a behavior penalty be imposed that the one that was applicable at the time penal offense was committed.
