**HUMAN RIGHTS**, thus, is concerned in a universalistic and egalitarian fashion. Such entitlements can exist shared norms of actual human moralities as justified moral norms or natural rights supported by strong reasons or as legal right either at a national level or within international law. However, there is no consensus as to prelude nature of what in particular should or should not be regarded as human right in any of the preceding senses and the abstract concept of human rights has been a subject of intense philosophical debate and criticisms.

On the other side, economists are often skeptical concerning the economic effects of various forms of human rights: it has been argued that basic human right can make the legal system less efficient but also extensive social rights are incompatible with market economies. It is argued here that the basic human rights are a pre condition for other kinds of rights such as property and civil rights and that they are thus efficiency-enhancing. Four different groups of rights are identified. It is asked what effects they have in welfare and growth. The transmission channel through which the different rights affect welfare and growth are identified by estimating their effects on investments in both physical and human capital and overall productivity. Basic human rights have indeed positive effects on investments, but do not seem to contribute productivity. Social or emancipatory rights, in turn, are not conducive to investment in physical capital but do contribute to productivity improvements.

In addition, the forum investigates human rights issues affecting business operations and supply chains in emerging markets, weak governance zone or in geographies where there are substantial human rights challenges.

However, there were several factors that contributed to the violations of the humans. These are:

1. The state. State commits rights violations for different reasons. Rulers may believe that such violations are necessary in order to maintain power, undermine or destroy the opposition, and impose some world view or economic organization of society. Or they may think that some types of violations are necessary evils when faced with certain risks. For example, torture or indefinite detentions can appear to be reasonable price to pay in

order to reduce the risks of terrorism. States can also violate human rights unintentionally: lawmakers can draft a legal system that unnecessarily encroaches on private freedom. And, finally, a state can violate a right, not as in the previous cases-by doing something it shouldn't do, but by failing to do what it should do: a state that doesn't provide an efficient judiciary or police force will be unable to protect the rights of its citizens and will be an accessory to rights violations.

2. Selfishness. In the case of economic rights- such as the right not to suffer poverty- it's often greed, lack of compassion or generosity. Or the absence of sufficient and adequate aid and intervention that causes rights violations. Selfishness can cause both individuals and states to violate rights. States, for example can uphold international trade structure or protectionist legal systems that favor the local economy at the expense of relatively poor exporters elsewhere.
3. Culture. Some say that certain elements of cultures and religions lead to practices that violate human rights. Here as well, we see both states and individuals can use cultures as a reason to violate rights.

As a matter of fact, Human right has been abused as years passed. Such reasons why it is abused are in terms of:

1. Sexual humiliation- viewed as a way to destroy male and community pride or humiliate men who cannot protect their women. It is also used to silence women who are politically active or simply inflict terror upon the population at large.
2. Discrimination- where basic rights may be denied on the basis of religion, ethnicity, race or gender.
3. Killing and torture- it is a way to carry out interrogations and extract confession or information.

To hell with this purposes! Don't they know that all humans are born free and equal in dignity and rights? Humans are endowed with reasons and conscience and should act towards one another in a spirit of brotherhood. We hold these truths to be self-evident that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by the creator with certain unalienable rights, that among these are life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness... dear people, this too much... let us make change...!
