Human rights, is basically under bill of rights, which may be expound as a declaration and enumeration of a person's right and privileges which the constitution is designed to protect against violations by the government or by an individual or groups of individuals. It is a charter of liberties for the individual and limitations upon the power of the state.

A man should be exempt from being compelled to be a witness against himself. He has right to protest and fight for himself, and one who shall push him to a crime without any evidences shall suffer under legal laws. One shall confront and cross-examine the witness against him at the trial and not outside the trial court and once prove that a man is guilty shall be detained under the permission of legal laws. But once the victim be condemned or be detained arbitrary without any legal evidences, the public officer or the employee shall suffer.
